This disconnect is reflected in the numbers:

61%

of college graduates

would change their majors if they could go back. (BestColleges Survey, 2020)

29%

of U.S. 10th graders

say they get to learn things they are interested in while 71% of parents with 10th graders think they do. (Brookings Institution and Transcend Report, 2025)

Students need earlier opportunities to explore their passions in ways that are engaging and relevant.

Schools that **fail to offer flexible, student-centered pathways** risk delivering on their school mission to equip and prepare future-ready students, while those that embrace personalization open doors for deeper learning and broader definitions of student success.

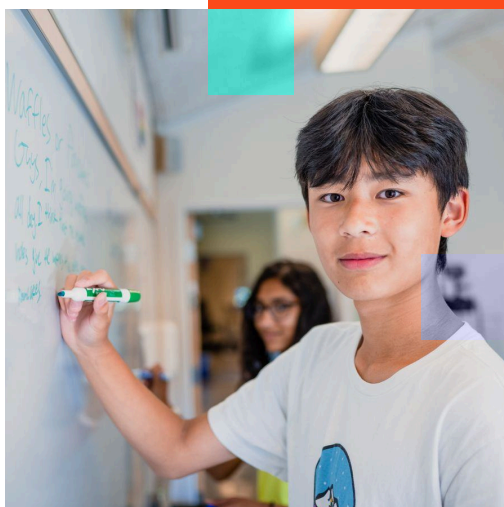


How Schools Are Expanding Student Pathways

Support Students with Pathways That Prepare Them for College & Beyond

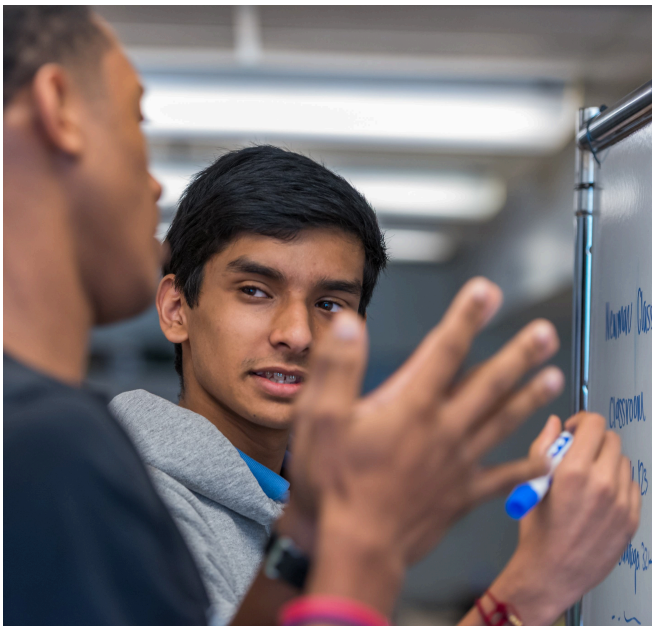
Learning pathways help students shape their academic journey and emphasize it during the college admissions process.
